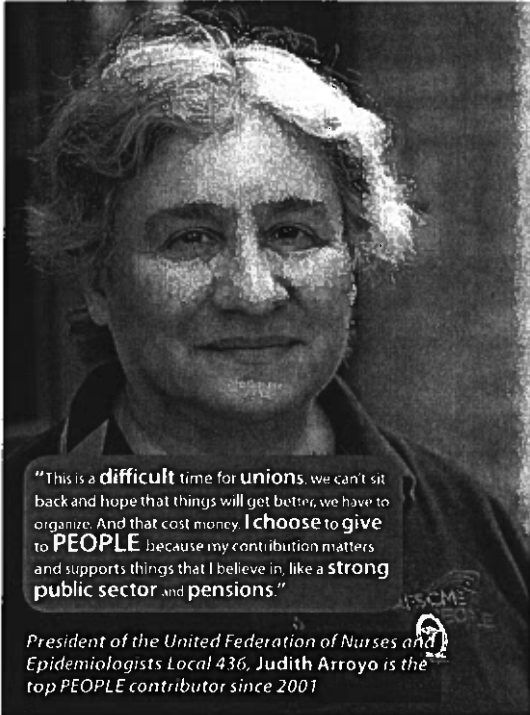

What is PEOPLE? PEOPLE is our voluntary political action fund.

Why do we need PEOPLE? We need our own war chest to fight the attacks on our members. By law, we can't use members' dues money to wage our campaigns to elect candidates who stand by working families, or to oppose those who seek to deny us our rights.

What are PEOPLE contributions used for? PEOPLE money helps us set the table to fulfill the union's mission—protecting and strengthening working families. We use PEOPLE dollars to fight for and enforce better contracts; safeguard our pensions; elect candidates who share our values and hold them accountable at all levels—local, state and federal; lobby to pass or stop laws/legislation.

Upcoming 2020 Early Voting, Primary, Special Election, & Election Dates

★ **March 24:**

Early Voting Dates for this Special Election: March 14 thru March 22

- **Special Election** for Queens's Borough President. *NOTE: For registered voters in Queens only. Voter Registration Deadline: Post marked and in person – Friday, February 28, 2020*

★ **April 28:**

Early Voting Dates for Special Election: April 18 thru April 26

- Presidential primary. All registered voters in New York can vote in their party's primary on this date. Voter Registration Deadline: Post marked and in person – Friday, April 3, 2020.
- **Special Election** for the 37th City Council District in Brooklyn. The 37th City Council District covers parts of Brooklyn that includes Cypress Hills, Bushwick, Ocean Hill, Brownsville, and East New York. *NOTE: Only for registered voters living in the 37th City Council District.*

★ **June 23:**

Early Voting Dates for the Primary Election: June 13 thru June 21

- Primary for all New York seats in the U.S. House of Representatives. Voter Registration Deadline: Post marked and in person – Friday, May 29, 2020.
- Primary for all seats in the New York State Assembly and New York State Senate
- Primary for Queens's borough president, for the remainder of Melinda Katz's term. *NOTE: Only for registered voters in Queens.*
- Primary for the 37th City Council District in Brooklyn. *NOTE: Only for registered voters living in the district.*

★ **October 9:**

- Voter Registration Deadline for General Election: Post marked and in person – Friday, October 9, 2020.

★ **November 3:**

Early Voting Dates for the General Election: October 24 thru November 1

- General Election for president, for all New York seats in the U.S. House of Representatives, New York State Assembly & New York State Senate.
- General Election for Queens's borough president, for the remainder of Melinda Katz's term. *NOTE: Only for registered voters in Queens.*
- General Election for the 37th City Council District in Brooklyn. *NOTE: Only for registered voters living in the 37th district.*
