## **COVID-19 SERUM ANTIBODY IgG Blood Test**

### **What is the COVID-19 Serum Antibody test and what does it measure?**

- *The COVID-19 antibody test measures the level of coronavirus "IgG" antibodies in the bloodstream.*
- *These antibodies appear approximately two weeks after the onset of infection. If there are antibodies present, the person has very likely been infected with COVID-19.*
- *This antibody test is most reliable when used more than 14 days after the end of symptoms. As a result, patients are advised to wait until they have been free of symptoms for 2-4 weeks to ensure accurate results.*

### **What criteria do I need to meet to receive one of these tests?**

- *If you previously had COVID-19 symptoms (Fever, persistent cough, shortness of breath, body aches) and have recovered after 14 days.*
- *If you received a positive test result for COVID-19 and have recovered after 14 days.*
- *If you believe you have come in contact with someone who had the COVID-19 virus.*

### **How are these tests administered?**

- *The Serum Antibody IgG (Blood Test) is administered via a blood sample.*

**How long will it take to receive my results and how do I view them?**

- *Generally, it will take 3-5 days to receive your antibody results.*

**What platform do you use for testing?**

- *For serology, the below health care providers are using the Abbott platform which has FDA Emergency Use Authorization.*

**How much do each of these tests cost?**

- *There is no co-pay and your insurance company will not be billed.*

**What precautions do I take based on my results of these tests?**

- *Serum Antibody IgG (Blood Test): Regardless of your results, you should continue to exercise universal precautions such as social distancing, quarantining, frequent hand washing, wearing of a mask or face cloth in public, and other CDC guideline recommendations.*
- *Remember, COVID-19 is a new infection, and it is unclear if a positive antibody definitively offers immunity.*

**Should I provide my results with the Medical Division?**

- *Yes. The results of this or any other medical exam are confidential and will be added to your medical folder. Should any health complications arise in the future our Police Surgeons will be better able to recommend a course of treatment. In addition, this information can be used to augment Line of Duty or Workers' Compensation paperwork.*
